This year we were blessed with great spring weather and the club was open for play in early March. The North and South Course have been in great condition from the get go and continue to impress visitors.

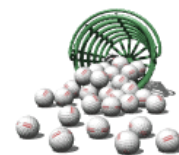

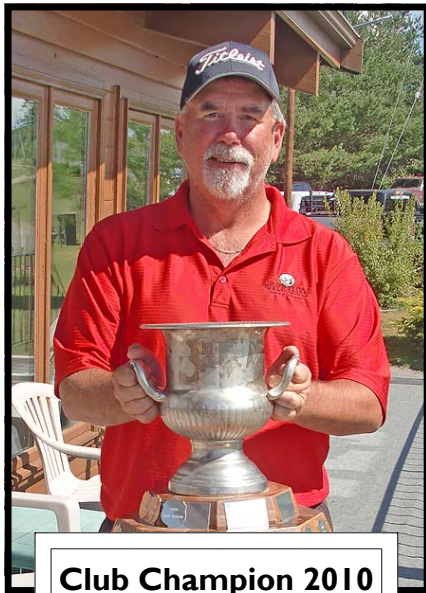


Senior Men's Club Championship 2010
