Dave Ryan recommended that we again purchase 9 small plaques to award to the individuals who win the Club Seniors Championship, the South Course Seniors Championship and the Match Play – costs will be covered by the various event fees - **AGREED**

7.RANGS: *Dave Ryan*

- Club Manager has asked for the sign-up sheet by noon on Monday (for both Mon and Wed games)
- Trevor usually makes up the schedule by Wednesday

- If you can't play, make sure you call the Pro Shop early in the morning so the schedules can be adjusted.
- No shows create a big problem for the Special Tournaments that are seeded by handicap.

- Rangs remain at \$ 2.00 and will be awarded for lowest net score on a hole (limit 2 Rangs a player per outing), plus a Rang for Low Gross or Low Net for the 18 holes.
- **Please arrive at least 20 minutes before your tee time, or you may have been replaced.**
- **All are required to record their rounds to keep their handicaps current.**

- **On hazard holes (and especially when playing our South Course rules) please drop where you cross into the hazard(woods) and not where the ball may have ended up.**
- On the North Course hole # 9 red stacks (lateral hazard) have been placed all the way down the left and right hand side of the fairway. That consists of a hazard from #9 over to # 8 fairway and # 9 over to # 1 fairway as a lateral hazard. If you go into a lateral hazard and play a second ball from the tee that becomes the ball in play. i.e. First ball goes into the lateral hazard and when hitting the second ball it also goes into the hazard. You are now laying in 4 and hitting 5 from where the 2nd ball crossed the hazard.

Course Improvements:

- Club Manager Kevin Kerr was asked to relocate the #9 tee on the South Course to the right, to improve the angle of approach.
- When tee markers are misaligned, the first group out should correct the problem.
