<u>HANDICAPS</u>: Handicaps are used for the Rang Games and all tournaments. Please enter all your rounds. Handicaps are properly calculated for those who post hole-by-hole scores. Those who use their total score must ensure it is their adjusted score. Dave usually updates the handicaps weekly for the Rangs.

RANGS: - \$ 2.00/game - starts on Monday - May 14

Start time is 10am in April and May, then 9am for June, July, August and September.

After our Closing in September, golfers are to gather at 10am, and teams will be assigned for that day. (If numbers warrant, Rangs may be collected and will be awarded at the end of October).

Posted Tee Times need to be respected – don't start early. Golfers should arrive at least 15 minutes before their posted Time.

New Rules of Golf coming in 2019: The R&A and the USGA have announced new and improved rules of golf to take effect on January 1, 2019. Dave Ryan passed a sheet on these new rules and highlighted the main ones. After due consideration, it was MOVED that the River Oaks Seniors **implement these new rules immediately for the Rang games**. Moved by Dave Ryan, Seconded by Frank LeBlanc. MOTION CARRIED

A few of the changes

- a) The 5 minute **golf ball search time** has been scrapped; golfers will be allowed only **3 minutes to search** for a strayed golf ball.
- b) Expanded Penalty Areas (play as hazards) = drop near point of entry -1 stroke penalty
- c) The Dropping Procedure Golfers can now drop from knee height. When taking relief golfers will now drop from knee height, no longer shoulder height.

Awarded Rangs: Dave Ryan reviewed the Rangs awarded over the last 5 years and presented his findings.

104 rangs were awarded to the 15-18 handicap group

130 rangs were awarded to the 19-22 handicap group

184 rangs were awarded to the 23-27 handicap group

187 rangs were awarded to the 28-37 handicap group

In conclusion it was agreed to continue with the current system.

Rangs are awarded for the lowest net score on a hole and a maximum of 2 hole rangs can be won in a single round. In addition a Rang is awarded to both the Low Gross and Low Net scores (but you can't win both for the same game). So, a golfer could win up to 3 rangs in a single game.
